

BALTIC SUPER LEAGUE 2017/18

TOURNAMENT RULES

Guaranteed 5 games for each Team. All games are played by WCF rules (**NEW 5 guard rule**).

Max 10 ends + extra ends. Time limit – 38 minutes thinking time for each Team per game.

Each Team has 5 minutes for the practice before every game. In group stage games two players from each Team must throw LSD shots to decide hammer.

Teams listed first plays with dark stones and start practice first.

After groups stage Teams are ranked in group by:

- Wins
- Mutual games
- Average LSD in all group stage games

Before play-off games all Teams are ranked by place in the group and average LSD. Groups winners are ranked 1st and 2nd, depending on average LSD, groups 2nd places are ranked 3rd and 4th, depending on average LSD, etc. In the play-off games Team which is ranked higher gets hammer in the first end and starts practice first. Opponents can choose Color of the Stones.
